The summer science program is for students who missed the opportunity to take science at any time during their middle school career, or struggled during middle school science. This camp will develop skills to help students be successful in freshman science. Each day, students will participate in a variety of fun and challenging hands on activities focusing on the sciences: physical, chemistry, and biology (possibly a little forensics too).

Students will learn about cells as well as get their hands dirty in the garden; create chemical reactions in the lab with color changes and large gas production; and learn what we can do to limit the harmful effects of gravity. ☺

Activities will possibly include edible cell, bean plants, elephant toothpaste, ice cup challenge (thermodynamics), egg drop challenge, Mentos rockets, solar cars, practice using different science tools (hot plates, thermometers, beakers, graduated cylinders, etc.)

Attendance

Good attendance is necessary for students to be successful in the short, but intense, summer program. **Therefore, students participating in “credit recovery” cannot be awarded credit if they miss more than two days FOR ANY REASON.** There is no differentiation between excused and unexcused absences in the summer program. Three tardies equal one absence, and each tardy of fifteen (15) minutes or more will equal one absence. No refunds, full or partial, will be given for days missed for any reason or for students dropped from the program due to excessive absence.

Discipline

All students must demonstrate a reasonable ability and willingness to conform to the dress code and behavior standards of the summer school program. Those students whose behavior is deemed unsafe or detrimental to the learning environment in any way may, upon the discretion of the summer school administrator, be removed from the program.

Any student removed from the program for disciplinary reasons will not be entitled to receive any refund of fees paid for participation.

Dress Code

1. Students will not wear clothing promoting alcohol, drugs, tobacco, sex or gangs.
2. Students will not be allowed to wear shorts and skirts that are too short. (Garments are considered too short if fingers, with arms relaxed and to the side, extend past the lower edge of the garment.)
3. Students may not wear skimpy tops or clothing that does not cover underwear. (Tops must meet pants or skirts when standing in a relaxed position.)
4. Students may not wear sunglasses in the building.

Behavior Standards

1. Students riding bicycles and skateboards to school are expected to WALK their bikes and CARRY their skateboard on school grounds.
2. Students are expected to follow classroom rules and demonstrate respectful attitudes and behaviors.
3. Students may not have cells phones, radios, CD/tape players, electronic games, etc. turned on while at summer school.
4. Students are expected to demonstrate respect for school property.
5. Students may not chew gum in the building.
6. Use of inappropriate or disrespectful language will not be tolerated.
7. Students will not fight or engage in verbal, physical, or electronic harassment.
8. Students may not engage in any behavior that threatens their safety or the safety of those around them.
9. Students are expected to work diligently and make the most of the educational opportunity that summer school affords.

Violation of any of the above standards may lead to dismissal from the summer school program. I acknowledge that if my child is removed from summer school, for any reason, I will not be entitled to receive any refund of tuition paid.
